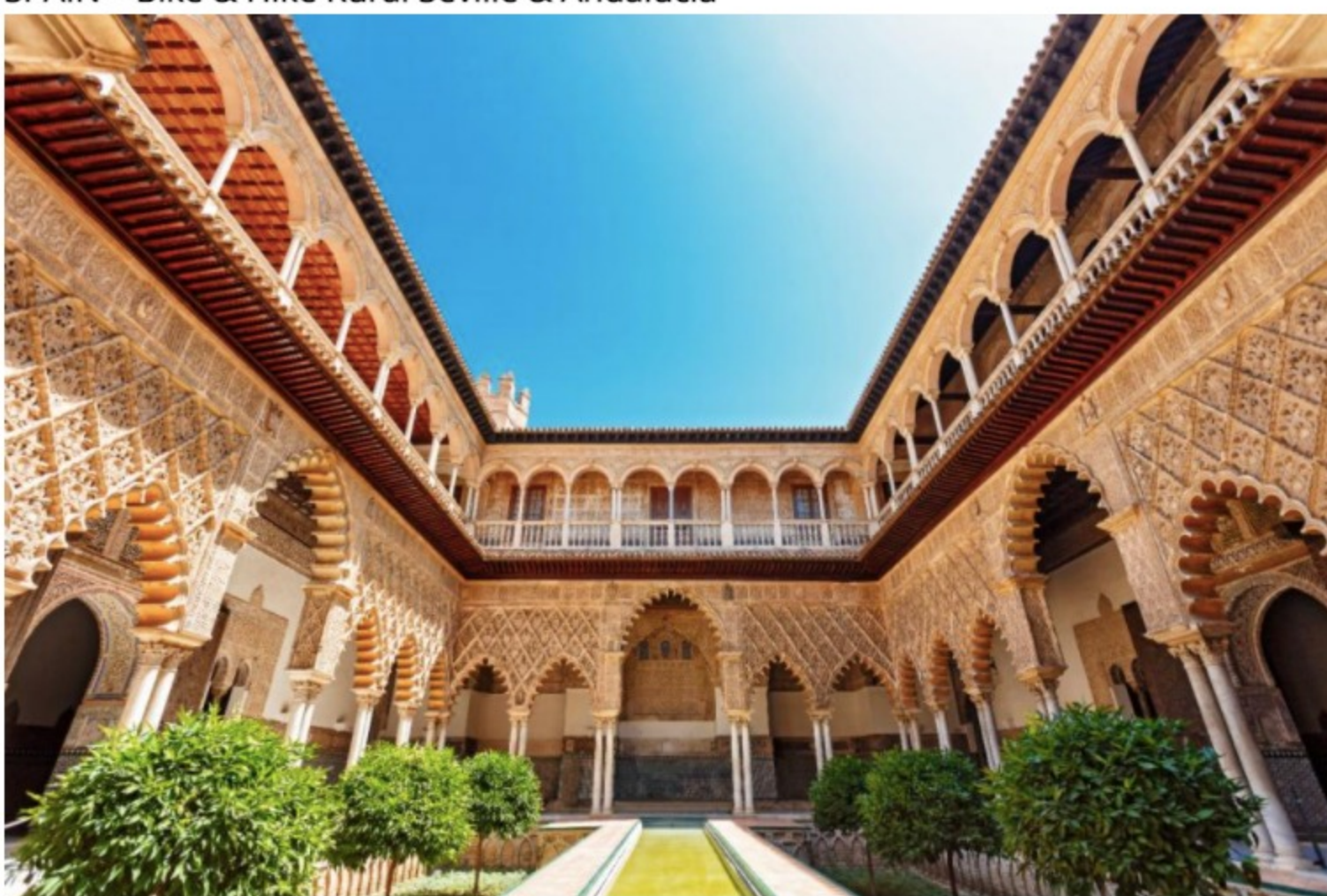
### ITALY – Ancient Taormina

### ITALY – Puglia, Lecce & Apulian Coast

### SPAIN – Bike & Hike Rural Seville & Andalucia

This is discreetly luxurious eco-retreat set high in the Sierra de Grazalema, Andalucia. Guests can hike and bike to their retreat's content in the Sierra de Grazalema National Park, or try horse riding as the estate is complete with 70 Lusitano horses, a dressage area plus lessons and trails for everyone from novice to experienced.
